Notice of Referee Course:

Date: Saturday 28th May 2011

Venue: Kwinana Recreation & Leisure Centre, cnr Gilmore & Chisham Avenue, Kwinana.

Course type: Qualifying C, IC, 4th, 3rd, 2nd and 1st class referee qualifications.
All referees have to re-qualify their referee class level every 4 years to remain current. Australian qualifications are required if you wish to remain current and to referee in Australia. Assessments and tests will be conducted on the day.

This course will cover all the latest competition rules, including the latest 2011 WTF rule amendments as implemented by the WTF for 2011 events.

Registration: from 8:30 am. The referee application form is enclosed, please complete details and bring to the course with payment or send in at least 1-week prior, with the appropriate course fee total as structured below. Work out your own fee payable. .

Course times: 9:00 am to approx 5:30 pm finish; lunch break for 30 minutes.
C, IC and 4th class will finish earlier at approx 4:30 pm.
Those attending to refresh knowledge or awareness can finish anytime after lunch.

Dress code: Taekwondo uniform with gym training shoes

Course fees: Use this table to determine the course fee total for your situation:

\$40 for refresher (or awareness) course (no testing)

\$55 for C and IC class qualifying (includes theory and scoring tests and NRC certificate)

\$75 for 4th class and higher qualification or re-qualification or upgrading (includes \$20 for accreditation fee).

\$20 for the full colour Referee Competition Rule book (not compulsory but recommended).
Or \$10 for the black & white print of rules and interpretation only.

If paying by cheque, please make cheque out to Taekwondo WA Referee Board.

Please refer to the table in the next page which details the different referee classes available in Australia for members to qualify. This includes requirements such as dan rank, practical refereeing at tournaments, age criteria, elapsed time since the last qualification criteria, theory, scoring and referee practical exam minimum pass marks.

If you are unsure of your status and what you need to do regarding if you needed to upgrade (to a higher referee class) or to re-qualify (elapsed 4 years after your last qualification) or for re-accreditation (after 2 years elapsed), call me or email to verify.

NRC Accreditation
National Referee Committee (NRC)
Referee qualification / Renewal / Refresher



Referee class levels: Must renew every 2 years for NRC Accreditation and every 4 years with NRC qualification. Experiences must be recorded in the NRC logbook or NRC log sheet and verified. Events must be sanctioned by the TA National or the TA state affiliated State Referee committees.

<p>C –class Club judge</p>	<p>This level is introduced to qualify blue belts of age 14 years and above. This qualification will qualify members to corner judge tournaments at internal club level tournaments only (ie a tournament that does not include other clubs).</p>
<p>IC –class Inter-club Judge</p>	<p>This level is introduced to qualify red belts of age 15 years and above. This also includes black belts of age 15 to 18 years. This qualification will qualify members to corner judge tournaments at inter club level tournaments and is a bridging course to become NRC referee officials. A Club class judge can apply for IC class upon reaching red belt if the qualification is achieved within 2 years.</p>
<p>4th class State Judge</p>	<p>Minimum holder of 1st dan black belt aged 18 years and over. Must pass course requirements. Those who can demonstrate recent pass level requirements from C class can apply for credit towards 4th class referee qualifications, but course attendance is still required, if not done within 2 years. Qualifies referees to officiate at state level tournaments as a corner judge.</p> <p>NRC accreditation renewal requirements: Must demonstrate participation in at least 2 sanctioned events as corner judge and attended 1 refresher course within 2 year period.</p>
<p>3rd class State Referee</p>	<p>Must have satisfactorily judged at least 4 sanctioned tournament events after obtaining 4th class referee. Must have passage of a minimum of 1 year since obtaining 4th class referee. Must have the minimum rank of 1st dan. Must pass course requirements.</p> <p>Qualifies referees to officiate as referee and corner judge at all state level tournaments, and as corner judge at national events. Experienced 3rd class referees can be considered to referee colour belts and junior black belts at national level events.</p> <p>NRC accreditation renewal requirements: Must demonstrate participation in at least 2 sanctioned tournaments or 8 simulation events or equivalent combination of tournament or simulation events as referee or 1 refresher course attended within 2 year period.</p>
<p>2nd class National Referee</p>	<p>Must have a minimum rank of 2nd dan. Must have satisfactorily refereed and judged at least 8 sanctioned tournament events after obtaining 3rd class referee, and satisfactorily refreshed at 2 referee courses or seminars. Must have participated at state simulation events as referee in at least 4 simulation sessions. Must pass course requirements. Must have passage of a minimum of 2 years since obtaining 3rd class.</p> <p>Qualifies referees to referee and corner judge at all state level and national level tournaments. Eligible to referee and corner judge at national selection level tournaments.</p> <p>NRC accreditation renewal requirements: Must demonstrate participation in at least 2 sanctioned tournaments or 8 simulation events or equivalent combination of tournament or simulation events as referee and 1 refresher course attended within 2 year period.</p>
<p>1st class National Referee</p> <p><i>S-class Senior National Referee is available for those of 4 dan+ higher and with more than 4 years after 1st class</i></p>	<p>Must have the minimum rank of 3rd dan. Must have satisfactorily refereed and judged at least 12 sanctioned tournament events after obtaining 2nd class referee, and satisfactorily completed 3 sanctioned referee courses or seminars. Must have participated at state simulation events as referee in at least 6 simulation sessions since obtaining 2nd class. Must have officiated at least 1 national level and-or 1 national selection event. Must pass course requirements. Must have passage of a minimum of 3 years since obtaining 2nd class.</p> <p>Qualifies referees to referee and corner judge at all state, national level and national selection level tournaments. Qualifies referees to be eligible to attend international level referee courses and qualify as an international referee.</p> <p>NRC accreditation renewal requirements: Must demonstrate participation in at least 2 sanctioned tournaments or 8 simulation events or equivalent combination of tournament or simulation events as referee and 1 refresher course attended within 2 year period.</p>
